

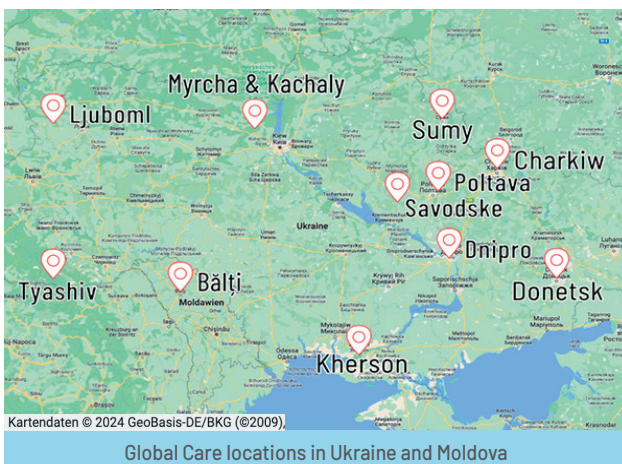


War in Ukraine – We continue to help!

February 24, 2024 marks the second anniversary of the war in Ukraine. The situation is devastating, people are carrying an unfathomable burden. Global Care has taken responsibility and supports the affected people in Ukraine and the neighboring country Moldova together with local partner organizations. Evacuations, regular distributions of food packages for 1,000 families and the reconstruction of 30 residential homes are part of the support implemented by Church of God in Ukraine. Children are especially close to our hearts – Global Care furthers the distribution of school supplies, enables online-classes and language courses for Ukrainian children in Moldova as well as summer camps for 855 girls and boys, so they can let go of their worries about the war.

Milana fled from Ukraine to Moldova together with three of her children. She is one of 3,920 people who receive help from Global Care at the education center in Bălți. She had to leave behind her husband and oldest son. First they were at the front line, then they fled out of fear for their lives and are still in hiding to this day. Milana is thankful that she is safe.



She collects clothing, saves food and regularly sends emergency packages from Moldova to her husband and son.

One hero of the Global Care emergency help is Pastor **Andrej**. At the risk of his life, he evacuates people in emergency situations and helps those in need by organizing aid transports and delivering help packages to contested regions.

Pastor **Aleksej** and his family have fled to Ljuboml. There they have found accommodation in the Church of God building that serves as a shelter for refugees. Aleksej wants to give back the help he has received. He and his wife are committed to helping: preparing meals, renovating and chopping wood for the winter.

Jeva also resists the war daily. Together with other women, she produces dried vegetables, pickles in preserving jars and baked goods. Jeva bakes and cooks for soldiers at the front - she wishes for her country to have a future.
